

ICA Ukraine 2019 report

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The year of transformation of ICA Ukraine under mentorship of ICA USA. During this year ICA Ukraine has updated its logo, officially registered the ToP trademark, started with implementation of a new strategy and ToP Policy in Ukraine.

Being part of an international organization, ICA Ukraine directs all its efforts to implementing the mission “development of human capital and local communities”. It relies on ICAI values, ethical and cultural norms in its activities.

The cooperation with other ICAs for development of a professional ToP network in Ukraine remains the cornerstone of its new strategy.

Our major achievements over the 1st half of 2019:

- Implementation of the “Rule of Law Program in Ukraine”, Washington DC, March 19-24, 2019
- Implementation of the “Women's Leadership and Democratic Governance Development Program”, Washington DC, March 19-26, 2019
- Participation in the meeting of the ICA - USA Archive, Chicago, April 15-17, 2019
- Delivery of the TOP facilitation training - Level 1 in March 2019 for NGO ISAR Ednannia, 27 participants
- Design and facilitation of the 2-days development of Ukrainian BioTech Cluster by ToP tools, 150+ participants
- Local Government Planning Training (Kyiv)
- 2 days strategy session for Dubno National Historical Reserve
- Strategy session for Rotary Kyiv-City Club

Our plans till the end of 2019:
